



2021 MDCACP Scholarship Grants

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Any Miami-Dade County graduating high school student who is at least 18 years of age;
or
- Any Miami-Dade County resident who is at least 19 years of age;
and
- The candidate must meet all of the minimum FDLE law enforcement officer certification requirements;
- The candidate must have earned a high school diploma or GED equivalent from an accredited institution;
- The candidate must receive a recommendation by an Executive Committee Member of the Miami-Dade County Association of Chiefs of Police.

HOW MANY ARE AWARDED AND HOW MUCH ARE THEY WORTH?

A minimum of one (or more) scholarships will be awarded annually to cover ONLY the tuition cost of attending the police academy. Recipient has up to two years to use the scholarship funds awarded.

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

All applications for scholarships must be accompanied by documentation detailed in the application package.
